**Treasurers' report:** G/A: £7,320.40 C/F: £8,955.32. Payments: Room Hire £50. Academy team support/food for season £240. Receipts: Memberships £115.

## **Feedback on meeting with club:**

(a) Back to Boro: Fund raising for this and nominated charity. No specific cost given from club. Club will be fund raising. Funds raising by Coop will be retained by ourselves.

(b) Disabled facility: Roger proposed to get someone onsite to discuss position etc.

(c) 200 Club membership: Still no response from club regards joining by staff and players. Proposal to send email to club about this. Parents of Academy should be approached, email to Frankie Fry by Roger.

(d) Anker Radio: Report from Harry Warren

(e) Programme/Andy Pace: Club not to accommodate Andy Pace with shed for sale of old programmes. Offers of use of social club for this, with which we could help him, is not acceptable by Andy. The club have stated that they would be pleased to see him back.

(f) Match day experience: Coop asked if they were prepared to provide wine for MOM presentations. This was discussed, and in the light of little response, from the club towards the Coop, it was pointed out that at a previous meeting, that this was the club's responsibility to do MOM presentations and generally improve the post-match experience.

(g) Structured timetable for meetings with club: Monthly meetings to be proposed. Next date 11<sup>th</sup> Oct proposed.

(h) Academy matches supported by Coop: A few problems at first game. Lack of publicity of game, over £114 took on gate, but mainly from away fans. Outside turnstile not suitable, must return to previous arrangements for entry. Team sheet could not be produced due to lack of Wi-Fi to connect to printer, official team sheets photocopied. After match refreshments, for both teams were available, provided by Co-op.

**Quiz Night:** This must be publicised for October 13<sup>th</sup> at Griff & Coton by email to all members and on social media, this could be a £300 fundraising event if supported properly. Prizes will be needed for raffle, and as many teams as possible.

**Race night:** Possibly in November, could a £1000 fund raiser.

**Christmas Raffle:** Tickets to be sourced and design presented at next meeting. 1000 tickets required. Raffle prizes to be sourced, usual items, but not cash prize.

**Membership drive:** 25% Life members now. Possible 30+ to still come in. Corporate sponsorship still coming in.
