Supporters' Director: Unfortunately, Andy Briggs has had to stand down from the committee due to increased work commitments. A vote of thanks was given to Andy for all his good work on the committee during the last few years. The Co-operative will look to continue the position of Supporters' Director with a new appointment as soon as possible.

Football Club: With no information forthcoming from the football club regarding any possible takeover, the Co-operative will be seeking a meeting as soon as possible, with the club, to clarify the position, also further questions would be on the agenda for the meeting.

AGM: The secretary reported that the AGM had gone ahead smoothly, although the number of members attending was a little disappointing. The suggestion was made that perhaps a quest speaker, after the AGM, next year, would attract more members. Information to the FCA has been submitted, and has been confirmed as being processed, by them.

Golden Ticket & Player Sponsorship: As confirmed at the last meeting, the Co-operative would again be taking part in the Golden Ticket Draw and sponsoring two players for the forthcoming season, possibly, Shane Bryne and Tom Elliot, if available.

200 Club: Dave Hall reported that one person had dropped out of the draw, but, hopefully more will join at the start of the season, including all contracted players. Draw for the month took place after the meeting.

A.O.B. Dave Hall reported that he had been contacted to act as an intermediary for the possibility of the youth team, of two seasons ago, returning to the football club. All the players were keen to return, all but two, who are contracted to their present club. A meeting took place between the youth team officials and football club manager, Kevin Wilson. Due to the uncertainty at the football club at the moment, it was agreed that it would be unfair to put their season at risk.

Roger Barnes reported that a meeting would be taking place on Monday, between the football club and Bramcote officials regarding the football club continuing to train there this season.

Roger also said that one of the items on the agenda, for a meeting with the football club, should be the disabled shelter facility.

Roger also told the meeting that he had attended the MAE Hospice Anniversary Dinner, where over £20,000 was raised for the hospice.

Mike Turner has been contacted by the football club about boxes of old club programmes which were about to be burned. He rescued them, and will be contacting Andy Pace regarding this matter.
