Player Sponsorship/Golden Ticket: It was proposed to offer the club a deal of £300 for sponsoring Mark Noon and Gavin Cowans. It was agreed to enter the Golden Ticket draw again and help with the event. In the event of winning the draw, what would the name be for the stadium, several suggestions were put forward.

Sound System/Lighting: Mike Turner quoted the price of a new system favoured by the club; this ran into several thousands of pounds. The sound system installed two years ago by the Co-operative was failing again, possibly due to rat damage again. Roger Barnes said he was disappointed with the present situation, having been involved originally, but was sure it could be repaired, but Mark Mortlock was reluctant to due the repair because of a dispute with the football club. If this dispute could be resolved, Roger Barnes said he thought the repair could be sorted.

It was agreed by the committee not to fund a new installation.

The lighting was on hold at the moment

Supporters' Direct Summit: The meeting agreed to send J. Hobson and M. Turner to the summit on 26th July at Wembley Stadium.

Newsletter: It was agreed to produce an edition of the newsletter, for the new season, perhaps an 8-page edition. Martin Ball asked for members to send any copy for it as soon as possible. It was agreed that the newsletter should appear quarterly. Andy Briggs suggested perhaps a profile of one of our corporate sponsors in each edition.

Membership: John Hobson said that we must push for renewals and new members, using a table in the club and one on the gate. Members would need to be approached for renewals, and also emails sent out and put on the website.

Meeting with Football Club: Andy Briggs had contacted Ian Neale about this, and was awaiting a call.

SD Membership/Submission of Accounts: Mike Turner would provide the required forms so that could be done as soon as possible. It was agreed to pay £200 for membership.

AOB: 200 Club, Dave reported 3 new members, 2 dropped out. He's spoken to Richard Dean about players to sign up for it. Golden Goal/50-50 tickets to be sold from the table only. Dave Cook said surely the best place for the club to sell was at the turnstiles.

Interviews are on going for the local co-ordinator/manager for the heritage project.

Pete Davis told the meeting of Jim Jarvis's next show in support of the hospice, tickets would sell fast.
