Minutes of last meeting; Passed as a true record

Chairman's report: A meeting has been arranged with Ian Neale on Tuesday, 24th June, 9pm.

The Co-operative have been invited by the football club to be involved with the Golden Ticket Draw for the ground naming event. It was agreed to look at it again, after the forthcoming meeting with the football club.

The football club have asked the Co-operative to provide content for the pre-season programmes. It was agreed that this would be a good chance to publicise the Co-operative's work of this last year, 200 Club etc.

Heritage Project: The chairman said we have been given permission to start the Heritage Project, the jobs for a local co-ordinator, and a project co-ordinator have been advertised and applications had started to come in, with the deadline being 30th June.

Andy Briggs pointed out that it was very important to be careful regarding employment laws i.e. procedure etc, and offered to help with this if necessary.

Dave Hall has spoken with Bob Turpey about the project, and he has said he would be very willing to help with it.

John Hobson pointed out that in the grant there was a budget for providing equipment that would be needed for the work, computers, scanners etc.

Player Sponsorship: The Co-operative have had an inquiry from the football club asking if we would be sponsoring players again next season, following Mark Noon and Gavin Cowans last season. After a discussion, it was decided to decide at a later meeting.

Youth Team/U16s: Dave Cook reported that they had training gear. No sponsorship had been forthcoming to date. Trials had been very positive. First team players, Gareth Dean and Adam Walker had been very supportive, attending every session so far. Training and pre-season games are at the college. Dave was asked to forward a list to John of what was needed, regarding kit etc, so the Co-operative could consider their help.

200 Club: Dave Hall proposed the June draw taking place at the AGM on 2nd July. One member has left. More members needed for next season. Two cheques for the football club's share of the last two draws were still held by the Co-operative (£605).

A.O.B.: Dave Hall said he was disappointed with the response towards the online petition against the FA's proposal for the reformation of the pyramid system of the leagues. He also said the lottery licence was due for renewal, a cheque was needed for this.
